Salt Lake International Airport to Logan (and reverse trip)

Salt Lake Intl. Airport to Logan

(85 miles - approx. 1.5 hours)

- Leave Salt Lake City International Airport on Terminal Drive.
- Take the I-80 E ramp on your left, sign to City Center/ Ogden/Provo.
- 3. Keep to the left and follow signs for I-80 E and merge onto I-80 E.
- 4. In less than a mile, take exit **117** toward **I-215 N** and **Ogden**.
- 5. In about 4 miles, take exit **26** on the left to **Legacy Parkway N**.
- Follow Legacy Parkway for approximately 12 miles until you reach I-15 N.
- Take exit 13 left and merge onto I-15 N for 38 miles through Ogden and on to Brigham City.
- 8. Take exit 362 for U.S. 89/91. Exit signs will say Brigham City/Logan/Utah State University.
- Stay on Hwy 89/91 for approximately 26.5 miles to Logan.

Logan to Salt Lake Intl. Airport

(85 miles - approx. 1.5 hours)

- 1. Leave heading south on Main Street (Hwy 89/91).
- Stay on Hwy 89/91 approximately 26.5 miles until it intersects with I-15 in Brigham City.
- Turn left and merge onto I-15 S through Ogden until you reach exit 324 for the Legacy Parkway, approximately 38 miles.
- Stay on the Legacy Parkway for approximately 12 miles where you will merge onto I-215 S.
- 5. Drive approximately 4.2 miles and take Airport **exit 22B**.
- Keep right at the fork and follow signs for the Airport/Bangerter Hwy.
- 7. Keep right at the fork and follow signs for the **airport** and merge onto **Terminal Drive**.
